For some time the Council have been actively considering how best to identify services that are no longer being provided by the principal Authorities and how best to use the Devolved Services budget that has been set aside to fund its aspirations. The Maintaining and Improving Services Working Party has asked the Staffing Committee to consider a job description for the possible appointment of a Community Warden. It was also asked to look at the Link Power Scheme that operates in Halcon, Taunton to see if this might be a suitable alternative. The proposals have also been discussed with Somerset Rural Youth Project who indicated that they might have been interested in becoming involved.

The aim would be to help improve the local environment – one of the areas the Council wished to focus on.
