





#### **Wellington Town Council**

#### Christmas Market & Lights Switch on Event – Saturday 26th November 2022:

A very successful Town Centre event saw a footfall of nearly 4,000 people attend annual Christmas Lights Switch On, despite very challenging wet and windy weather conditions.

Wellington Produce Market set up early with 27 stallholders plus 5 community group stalls. A mixture of stalls ranging from business promotion, crafts & gifts, chutneys, butchers, and pies & cakes.

From 12 noon we saw community groups and school children entertain the people of Wellington with array of Christmas carols and songs. The hire of the stage and its new location enabled us to protect the musicians, singers and performers from the elements. Street entertainers interacted with parents and children from 12pm until 6pm.Santa Claus arrived in an open top classic car accompanied by the Wellington Majorettes at approximately 4.20pm.

Ben Sellick of the Baptist Church delivered the Christmas message. Deputy Mayor Nancy Powell-Brace, on behalf of the Mayor, welcomed all to see the switching on of the Christmas lights. Georgia and Archie of Wellington Prep School lead the count down to the switch on.

The Town Council would like to thank Steve Hawker, Prosound & Lighting (Exeter), Fuse Performance Ltd, Dave and Jill Mitton (Community Centre) and Bridgwater Guy Fawkes Carnival for their hard work, time and support for delivering a successful event. We would also like to thank the Council officers, Councillors and volunteers who came along to help on the day, especially Aaron Fearnhead (Wellington Carnival), Roger Nunn (Friends of Wellington Park) and Chris Penney.

At the start of 2023, Town Council officers will be very busy organising events. We must re-iterate the importance that these events will not go ahead unless we have the help and support from volunteers and Councillors.

#### REVIEW AND RE-CONTRACT OF CHRISTMAS LIGHTING HIRE

For Town Centre Committee January 2023

#### 1. Background

- 1.1. The Council's current scheme is hired from The Festive Lighting Company at a cost of £8,713 this year. This includes lights for 2x trees, cross street banners, wall mounted motifs, 2x set of curtain lights and icicle lights in various locations. The scheme was a three year contract for 2020, '21 & '22. This price also includes storage.
- 1.2. A schedule from The Festive Lighting Company including some indicative images is attached at Appendix A.
- 1.3. The scheme is installed and removed by WGS Power and Lighting at a cost of £7,826.

#### 2. Public Consultation

- 2.1. A survey to gather opinion on the lights was agreed at the last Town Centre meeting and was available for the public to complete between 26<sup>th</sup> November and 9<sup>th</sup> January.
- 2.2.119 responses were received. The summary of results is attached at Appendix B.
- 2.3. Appendix C contains the detailed written responses.

#### 3. Next Steps

3.1. In order to draft a specification for the new contract, the Committee must indicate if they wish to expand the scheme beyond its current scope.

If no, a specification can be drawn up using the current schedule.

If yes, several other factors must be considered to determine a specification, such as

- Locations and types of additional motifs/installations
- Costings for additional fittings/infrastructure for additions
- Should a preferred colour scheme be identified?
- 3.2. If a 'yes' response to 3.1 above, the Committee are asked to provide a list of additions and/or amendments at the meeting to allow officers to gather the information and costings required for adding those items to the scheme. These matters will then be discussed at a special meeting in February.
- 3.3. An indicative timeline is detailed below. It should be noted that contractors expect orders to be placed in early summer of the commencement year of the contract.
- 3.4. Given the complexity of the project, it is recommended by the Officers that special meetings are called to specifically discuss the Christmas lighting where required.

They are perfect as they are I just wished people would be more considerate parking by the tree


They look lovely. Not sure what some people expect but for a small town they are great. I particularly like the ones on either side of the street.

#### **WELCOME TO WELLINGTON SIGNS**

For Town Centre Committee January 2023

#### 1. Background

- 1.1. Works to replace four 'Welcome to Wellington' signs was discussed at the Town Centre Committee in July 2022. At this meeting, it was agreed that the wording 'Gateway to the Blackdown Hills AONB' should be added to the signs.
- 1.2. Two additional 'Rockwell Green' signs were also requested.

#### 2. Wellington in Bloom Signs

2.1. Having spoken to their (now disbanded) committee, Wellington in Bloom feel that the additional signs detailing their awards can now be removed as they feel they are now somewhat outdated.

#### 3. Rotary

- 3.1. After the meeting, Richard Coupe e-mailed to ask if the Rotary logo could be included on the signs to advertise that the clubs are active in the town. This is often common practice in other areas. The logo has been forwarded to Highways to include as an option on the proofs. Highways have not indicated that the inclusion will incur additional cost.
- 3.2. The committee is asked to approve the inclusion of the logo.

#### 4. Highways

- 4.1. Having raised the project with Highways, they have stipulated that the signage must be replaced by their contractors via the Traffic Management department.
- 4.2. All the details are now with their designers, and it is hoped the proofs can be circulated by e-mail prior to the meeting.

#### 5. Costs

- 5.1. The price quoted by highways is £1,500 £2,300. This will be dependent on how many existing posts can be reused.
- 5.2. This project will be funded from the Promotion of Wellington budget line.

#### 6. Recommendation

6.1. It is recommended that the committee approve Officer spending of up to £2,500 to allow contingency for unexpected costs.
