

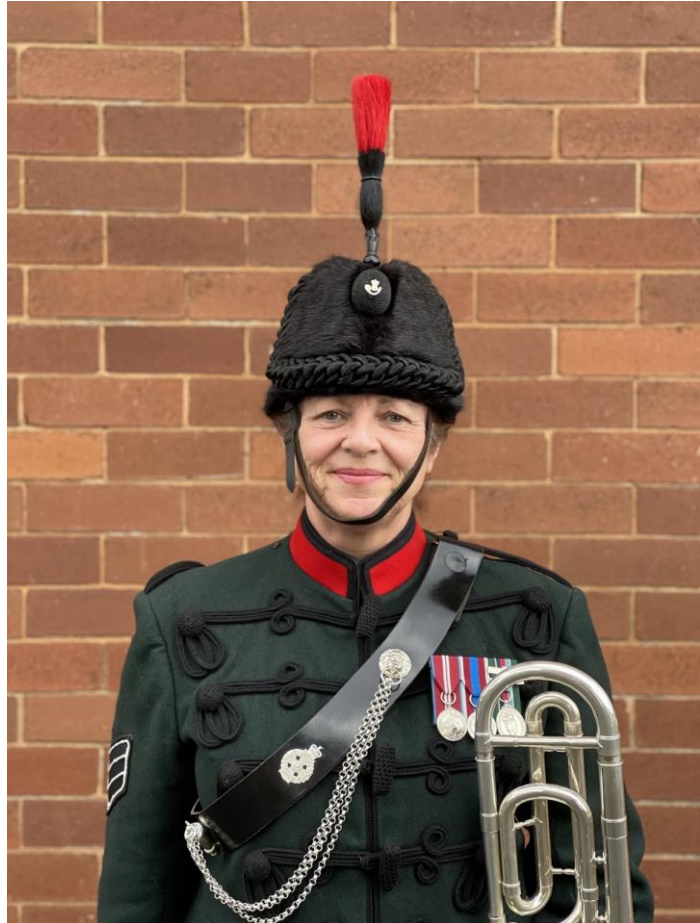
Sergeant Teresa Bulmer – The Rifles Salamanca Band & Bugles
