4. WELLINGTON TOWN CARNIVAL – SATURDAY 30TH SEPTEMBER 2023

Cllr Marcus Barr (Mayor) to hold Mayor's Reception in the Community Centre from 6pm. Approximately 50 guests + partners to be invited.

- a) Odette's Tea Room have been approached to provide a light buffet. Three prices provided:
 - £6.75 per head for sandwiches and cakes
 - £7.75 per head for sandwiches, cakes and scones
 - £9.95 per head for sandwiches, cakes and pastries

RECOMMENDATION to approve a budget of £500.00 for Council Officers to spend to cover costs for light buffet and drinks for the Mayor's Reception.

- b) The Committee to consider the cost of hiring a stage for the mayor's guests to view the carnival procession. To be positioned in front of the Old Post Office, High Street.
 - Pro Sound Lighting Quotation to provide a stage(rails back and sides)
 8m x 3m flat £680.00
 8m x 3m tiered (Step height 1st 30cm, 2nd 60cm, 3rd 90cm) £740.00

5. CHRISTMAS 2023

a) Christmas Expenditure

The Committee is asked to determine a budget for the Christmas 2023 entertainment based on the reports provided by the Assets & Events Officer attached to the agenda for recommendation to September Full Council meeting.

The budget allocated for Christmas 2023 is £10,000. Options for consideration:

- Increase the entertainment for the Christmas Market & Light Switch on event on Saturday 25th November 2023.
 - i. Santa's Grotto
 - ii. Snow Globe
 - iii. Toy Set Ride
- To review and consider Fuse Performance Ltd Street entertainment schedule. In the previous two years, costs were covered by the Emergency High Street Recovery Fund.

- Free Parking in North Street, South Street and Longforth Road Car Parks on Saturday 25th November for the Christ
- To invite a guest for the switch on. Suggestion Clinton Rogers to compere the event from 4.30pm to 6pm

b) Rockwell Green Christmas Tree

Officers have made every effort to find a suitable location on Exeter Road as previously requested by the Committee. However, Somerset Council will no longer approve the addition of sockets to lighting columns to power the lights on a standalone tree installation. To establish a new mains connection would be complex and potentially very costly. The committee are asked to agree to changing the location of the tree to the Christian Centre. Image attached with location agreed in principle with the Centre. This will be subject to final and formal agreement.
