404 TO CONSIDER WHAT COMMENTS TO MAKE ON THE FOLLOWING APPLICATIONS THAT WILL BE DETERMINED BY SOMERSET COUNCIL

(a) Case Ref: 43/23/0107

Proposal: Erection of a 72 No. bedroomed care home (Use Class C2) with associated access, parking, plant, landscaping and site infrastructure on land to the south-east of Exeter Road, Rockwell Green, Wellington

RESOLVED to recommend that this application be refused. Councillor Govier read comments from Paul Coles Service Director - ASC Commissioning with Somerset Council who questioned the need for the development as a similar facility will be built as part of a development between Wellington and Taunton. There are concerns about the impact on current health services which are already under significant strain. There are concerns about parking not being sufficient which will result in staff parking in the surrounding streets causing disruption to those residents. The sweep analysis document shows that multiple manoeuvres are required to enter and exit a parking space. Councillors agreed with concerns raised by the Placemaking Team Manager; the southern aspect is dominated by parking meaning that rooms being largely north facing will affect daylight into rooms and resident's visual aspect, the size of the proposed fence is too high and will again have an impact of resident's outlook, the outdoor spaces are lacking and the sustainability aspect needs improvement.

(b) Case Ref: 43/23/0108/T

Proposal: Application to carry out management works (crown-reduction) to one lime tree included in Taunton Deane Borough (Wellington No.3) Tree Preservation Order 1997 at Corams Lane, Wellington (TD760)

It was noted that this application had already been approved.

Proposal: Conversion of attic into ancillary accommodation with construction of rear dormer and raising of ridge height at 29 Seymour Street, Wellington
