

PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

The Somerset Council WG 17/17 (part) Wellington Public Path Diversion Order, 2024

The above order, made on March 28 2024 under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980, will divert the public footpath running from:

- the south side of Lillebonne Way at OS Grid Ref ST 13833 21386 (point F on order map H29-2023) north north west for approximately 37 metres to OS Grid Ref ST 13829, 21424 (point E on order map H29-2023)
- OS Grid Ref 13827, 21444 (point D on order map H29-2023) north north west for approximately 26 metres to OS Grid Ref 13824, 21470 (point C on order map H29-2023)
- 3. OS Grid Ref 13822 21489 (point B on order map H29-2023) north west for approximately 145 metres to OS Grid Ref 13760 21620 (point A on order map H29-2023).

To:

- A footpath starting from the south side of Lillebonne Way at OS Grid Ref ST 13833 21386 (point F on order map H29-2023) and running generally north west for approximately 5 metres, then north east for approximately 6 metres, then north west for approximately 11 metres then north east for 24 metres to OS Grid Ref ST 13829, 21424 (point E on order map H29-2023). The width is two metres.
- 2. A footpath starting at OS Grid Ref ST 13827, 21444 (point D on order map H29-2023) and curving north east then running north before curving north west for a total of approximately 29 metres to OS grid ref 13824 21470 (point C on order map H29-2023). It runs to the east of the lighting column. The width is two metres.
- 3. A footpath starting at OS Grid Ref 13822 21489 (point B on order map H29-2023) and running in a generally north easterly direction along a grass verge for approximately 64 metres to OS Grid Ref ST 13828 21555 (point Y on order map H29-2023) and then running on the west side of St Luke's Close, east of the hedge in a north westerly direction for approximately 63 metres to OS Grid Ref ST 13781 21595 (Point X on order map H29-2023) where it crosses the road, before continuing north west for a total distance of approximately 33 metres to OS Grid Ref 13760 21620 (point A on order map H29-2023). The width is two metres.



as shown on the order map.

Any representation about or objection to the Orders may be sent in writing to Rights of Way, Somerset Council, County Hall, Taunton, TA1 4DY, to be received not later than May 9 2024. Please state the grounds on which it is made.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, Somerset Council may confirm the order as an unopposed order. If the order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the order. At this stage they will be made available for public inspection. Prior to submission to the Secretary of State, representations and objections will only be disclosed anonymously (i.e. with personal data redacted).
