

**PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER  
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980**

**The Somerset Council  
WG 17/17 (part) Wellington  
Public Path Diversion Order, 2024**

This Order is made by Somerset Council ("the authority") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 (the 1980 Act) because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the owner of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this order it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

Bloor Homes South West has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public.

**BY THIS ORDER:**

1. The public right of way over the land situate at Wellington and shown by a bold continuous line on map H29-2023 contained in this order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this order shall be stopped up from the date of confirmation of this order.
2. Notwithstanding this order statutory undertakers shall have the following rights over the land referred to in paragraph 1: namely the same rights they had in respect to their apparatus under, in, upon, over, along, or across the said land as they had immediately before the confirmation of this Order.
3. There shall from the date of confirmation of this order be a public footpath over the land situate at Wellington described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the map contained in this order.

**DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATH OR WAY**

1. Part of public footpath WG17/17 starting from the south side of Lillebonne Way at OS Grid Ref ST 13833 21386 (point F on order map H29-2023) and


running north north west for approximately 37 metres to OS Grid Ref ST 13829, 21424 (point E on order map H29-2023)

2. Part of public footpath WG17/17 starting from OS Grid Ref ST13827, 21444 (point D on order map H29-2023) and running north north west for approximately 26 metres to OS Grid Ref ST 13824, 21470 (point C on order map H29-2023)
3. Part of public footpath WG17/17 starting from OS Grid Ref ST13822 21489 (point B on order map H29-2023) and running north west for approximately 145 metres to OS Grid Ref ST 13760 21620 (point A on order map H29-2023).

## PART 2

### DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATH OR WAY

1. A footpath starts from the south side of Lillebonne Way at OS Grid Ref ST 13833 21386 (point F on order map H29-2023) and runs generally north west for approximately 5 metres, then north east for approximately 6 metres, then north west for approximately 11 metres then north east for 24 metres to OS Grid Ref ST 13829, 21424 (point E on order map H29-2023). The width is 2 metres
2. A footpath starts at OS Grid Ref ST 13827, 21444 (point D on order map H29-2023) and curves north east then runs north before curving north west for a total of approximately 29 metres to OS grid ref ST13824 21470 (point C on order map H29-2023). It runs to the east of the lighting column. The width is 2 metres
3. A footpath starts at OS Grid Ref ST13822 21489 (point B on order map H29-2023) and runs in a generally north easterly direction along a grass verge for approximately 64 metres to OS Grid Ref ST 13828 21555 (point Y on order map H29-2023) and then runs on the west side of St Luke's Close, east of the hedge in a north westerly direction for approximately 63 metres to OS Grid Ref ST 13781 21595 (Point X on order map H29-2023) where it crosses the road, before continuing north west for a total distance of approximately 33 metres to OS Grid Ref 13760 21620 (point A on order map H29-2023). The width is two meters
