Under the archway there is a sign from the old Urban District Council - what does this sign say is not allowed?

The Iron Duke

What was The Iron Duke's real name? Hint: look at the information plaques on the front of the building.

St John's Church

Whose tomb is in the corner of the church?

Roly Poly Green/Old Maternity Hospital

Stand in the middle of the green - how many trees surround it?

Old Police Station

How many steps are there between the old police station and the new police station?



High Path

How many chimney pots are on the old farmhouse?

Springfield Road

Why do you think this road is called Springfield Road? The clue is in the name.

The Basins Nature Reserve

There is lots of wildlife here but the most noticeable are the swans - how many can you see?



Wellington Park

Wellington Park has a memorial for soldiers who died in the first and second world wars. Every year we come here to remember them. Do you know what day Remembrance Day is?

Wellington House

Look at the sign near the batting cages - who was Wellington House built for?

The Old Chapel

There is a memorial stone on the front of the building - what date was it laid?

Who is this cinema named after? Hint: You learned about him at The Iron Duke.
