1. Introduction

The Town Council are now responsible for the bus shelters within Wellington and Rockwell Green.

The Economic Development Committee agreed to look at a 3-year replacement and maintenance plan and budget balance.

Year 1 – Rockwell Green adjacent to Italian Restaurant

Year 2 – Milverton Road opposite the One-Stop shop.

Year 3 – St. John's Church, High Street

Council officers were given the task to present a plan with approximate costs for the committee to approve.

The Committee meeting held on 11th June 2025; it was resolved to approve the Three-year bus shelter replacement and maintenance plan.

The Committee are asked to consider the three quotations to replace the bus shelter adjacent to the Italian Restaurant, Rockwell Green and to look at maintenance work needed to the two bus shelters in the High Street. Outside Casey Warren Hairdressers and Old Post Office.

In addition, council officers are obtaining quotations to wrap the bus shelters. This will be presented at the next Economic Development Committee meeting in December 2025.

2. Background

In 2022 the previous Town Centre Committee asked GW Shelter Solutions to complete a survey and provide quotation on the current condition of the town centre bus shelters.

The report and quotations were presented to the committee in July 2022 where it was resolved to wait for the proposal from Somerset West and Taunton District Council's Senior Management Team to transfer the bus shelters to the Town Council.

All the above include aluminium seat, standard timetable case. old shelter disposal and *RTI (Real Time Information) displays.

RTI* – will be subject to power supply being available at the location.

Costs to be taken from the Economic Development Bus Cost Centre – Bus Shelter Budget line. At the Committee meeting held on 11th June 2025 it was resolved to use £5,000 from Town Centre Project budget to support the bus shelter planned works.

Where excavation work is involved, a licence/permit is likely to be required. Any costs associated with applying for permits, opening notices or additional information requested by the customer/contractor are excluded and will be charged extra.

Traffic Management – we understand this can be conducted from the layby. To be confirmed.

Quotation 2 - M J Fletcher Property Maintenance - £500 per bus shelter to rub down and repaint plus cost of timetable, approximately £150.00.

3) To approve £1500 delegated, spend for Council Officers to use on labour. GW Shelter Solutions to confirm labour costs for the two maintenance jobs under item 2.
